Islam also decrees that sexual activity may occur only between married individuals.

I cannot help believing that hidden in the notion of viriginity is a proclaimed aversion to sex. This assumption underlies that sex for its own sake is sinful; for instance it must be utilised for another. nobler, end-namely, procreation. Premarital sex is typically not meant to for such a goal. By extension of this train of thought a virgin (who has not had sex) is 'pure,' upon whom a man may after marriage play on and deflower. Such a position is hard to maintain rationally as commonsense tells us that sex is a natural instinct in any human just as much as breathing or defecating. And just as much as when breathing or defecating is interrupted severe complications can occur psychologists and psychiatrists have demonstrated that the deprival of sex can lead to severe malfunctioning in

The virginity idea has another problem and this is ethical. Why only expect a woman to be a virgin until marriage whereas a man may philander and plunder a girl of his choice? This seems to indicate that the upholding of virginity values are a product of male chauvinism.

Whatever, these kinds of arguments aver a reality check reveals that most of the Western world, at least, is departing from treating virginity as sanctimonious. If a minority wants to take the unusual step of actually having sex on their wedding night, instead of sleeping off a hangover, good luck to them."
