How are scholarship recipients selected?

- Japura Scholarship Committee collects applications every year from undergraduates with the help of The University of Sri Jayewardenepura.
- Five members of the Scholarship committee will assess each application based on published selection criteria and will award points. Applicants with highest points will be awarded that year's available scholarships. Japura Alumni Australia Inc. assures that only the most deserving applicants will be chosen using an unbiased and transparent selection process.
- Each scholarship is valid only for one year. New applications are required to be submitted every year for each scholarship by undergraduates, including those who have received scholarships in previous years.

If I donate, how is my money protected and used effectively?
