



## How to make your vote count. Federal election, Saturday 7 September.

On election day, you will receive two ballot papers: a green one for the House of Representatives and a white one for the Senate. On the green ballot paper you are voting for a representative of your local area in the House of Representatives. On the white ballot paper you are voting for representatives of your state or territory in the Senate.

Don't worry if you make a mistake. You can ask for another ballot paper and start again.




## White ballot paper - two ways to vote

On the **white ballot paper** you have a choice of two ways to vote:


## **EITHER - Above the line**

Place a '1' in the box for the party or group of your choice.



## OR - Below the line

Number every box in the order of your choice.
