impoverished communities.

We have several prominent people in our group, including Dr. Jennifer Johns (Ex director of Cardiology at Austin Health and ex president of Australian Heart Foundation), A/Prof. Andrew Cochrane (Cardiac Surgeon at Monash Heart), A/Prof. Omar Farouque (current director of Cardiology at Aus-

tin) and Dr. Dimuth de Silva (Melbourne Cardiologist) and many other medical specialists as well as dentists, general practitioners and allied health professionals who regularly visit Sri Lanka on our missions. We are currently focusing on providing teaching and training to rural hospitals, providing them with much needed equipment (cardiac catheter consumables, diabetes testing equipment etc..) and involving in teaching activities to rural universities. All volunteers in our group travel from their own expenses.
